SO YOU'RE THINKING OF APPLYING?


Many of the private schools with which we collaborate offer students the option to complete Advanced Placement (AP) courses as well as the option to graduate with an International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma, in addition to the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).

We now have partnering schools, spanning Durham, Toronto, Peel, York and Hamilton. The schools are listed as Co-Ed, All Boys and All Girls in alphabetical order. Please read the details in this document and attend the listed open houses with your children to learn more about each school. Please ensure that your child meets the eligibility requirements for the schools to which he/she may apply.

- Be involved with co-curricular and extracurricular activities
- Have great leadership skills and a healthy sense of community
- > Demonstrate good personal and social development
- Be resilient
- Be collaborative / good team player
- Have great organizational skills
- > Be well rounded / balanced
- Have critical thinking skills





HOW DO I APPLY THROUGH ACCN?

Please note our process and deadlines may differ from that of the schools.

If applying through ACCN, please follow our process/deadlines.

1. Complete the ACCN Application on or before Friday 18 October 2024.

PLEASE NOTE: Applications submitted directly to the private schools **cannot** be retrieved by the ACCN and are **not considered part of our process.**

- 2. Scan and create .pdf files for the last 3 years of school reports (i.e. June 2022, 2023, and 2024 school reports), using a naming convention such as John Doe 2021 report.pdf
- 3. Scan and create one .pdf file of all recognitions/accomplishments/achievements that speak of your child's great performance. These include, but are not limited to Honor Roll certificates, academic, community or extra-curricular recognitions. Use a naming convention eg John Doe supporting documents.pdf



HOW DO I APPLY THROUGH ACCN?

- 4. Upload school reports and supporting documents into the ACCN application form portal (the form will prompt you when to upload the files)
- 5. Send this <u>ACCN Confidential Teacher's Evaluation link</u> directly to your child's teacher to complete and inform him/her of the completion deadline.
- 6. ACCN will review your child's application and determine whether (s)he is eligible for an interview, at which time we will contact you. Those not eligible for an interview will be notified.
- 7. Families will be informed of recommendations made to the schools.
- **8. PLEASE NOTE**: Final decision of acceptance rests with each school applied to.

WHAT ABOUT APPLICATION DEADLINES?

The deadline for submission of ACCN's Applications is **Friday 18**th **October 2024.**

We strongly encourage families to apply sooner to secure an early interview date.

Completed files of qualified applicants will be forwarded to the schools before their application deadlines.

After your application is submitted to the school(s) of your choice, please check your e-mails, including junk and spam regularly for their correspondence.

Final acceptance decisions by all schools are usually communicated the 3rd week in February.



HOW CAN I ACCESS FINANCIAL AID?

The Independent schools usually award financial aid to families, based on the assessments made by their financial aid department, or by their choice of a third party, and their financial aid budget.






